About the Program

Public Safety Services provides training to 11th and 12th grade students in the fields of law enforcement, security, corrections and other public safety occupations.

Students learn in a classroom setting and through practical hands-on exercises pertaining to the public safety field.

Upon successful completion of the Program, students receive industry related certifications such as NYS Security Guard certification, AHA CPR/ AED certification, as well as multiple FEMA certifications.

Students will also have the opportunity to meet and learn from experts in the public safety industry and visit the following institutions:

- Sullivan County Courthouse

Industry Facts

- The Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), a part of the U.S. Department of Labor, classifies **law-enforcement and security jobs** as protective services occupations. The BLS expects that 364,500 new **jobs** will be added during the period from 2010 to 2020, which is equivalent to **11% growth**
- Benefits of a law enforcement career include:
 - * Shift differential pay
 - * Longevity pay
 - * Overtime, comp time, and court time for duty beyond the standard schedule
 - * Annual uniform allowances
 - * Periodic equipment allowances
 - * Health insurance
 - * Retirement plan
 - * Assignment/promotional opportunities
- Average salaries for law enforcement officers in the Hudson Valley range from **\$40,000 to \$150,000**; plus excellent benefits packages depending on location and assignment.
