Sullivan BOCES Notification of Potential Pesticide Use

Dear Parents, Guardians and School Staff,

New York State Education Law Section 49-H, effective July 1, 2001, requires all public and nonpublic elementary and secondary schools and daycare centers to provide written notification to all persons in parental relation, faculty, and staff regarding the potential use of pesticides periodically throughout the school year.*

Sullivan BOCES is required to maintain a list of persons in parental relation, faculty and staff who wish to receive 48-hour prior written notification of certain pesticide applications. The following pesticide applications are **NOT** subject to prior notification requirements:

- Anti-microbial pesticides and products
- Aerosol products with a directed spray in containers of 18 fluid ounces or less when used to
 protect individuals from an imminent threat from stinging and biting insects, including
 venomous spiders, bees, wasps and hornets.
- Nonvolatile rodenticides in tamper resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children.
- Silica gels and other nonvolatile, ready-to-use pastes, foams or gels in areas inaccessible to children.
- Nonvolatile insecticidal baits in tamper resistant bait stations or in areas inaccessible to children.
- Boric acid and disodium octaborate tetrahydrate.
- The application of EPA designated biopesticides (<u>www.epa.gov/pesticides/biopesticides/</u>)
- The application of EPA designated exempt materials under 40 CFR 152.25
- An emergency application of a pesticide to protect against an imminent threat to human health.
- A pesticide application which occurs when the facility remains unoccupied for a continuous 72 hours following the application.

If you would like to receive 48-hour prior notification of pesticide applications that are scheduled to occur in your school or facility, please complete the attached form and return it to the main office or mail to Sullivan BOCES – Health & Safety Office – 15 Sullivan Ave., Suite 1W, Liberty, NY 12754.
